WHEREAS

1. The settlor has decide to establish a fund for furtherence of public charitable object and for such purpose has made over a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand only) to the TRUSTEES by way of initial contribution .
2. The Trustees have agreed to become Trustees and to hold apply the said sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand only) and all gifts, contributions, grants, subscription donations, fees etc. received hereafter for charitable purposed, subject to the powers and provisions contained in this deed.
3. If the trustees desire to co-opt another eminent personalities as trustees for betterment of Trust they can co-opt but total number of trustees shall not be more than seven.
4. If any vacancy made in board of trustees these vacancy can be fulfilled by co-optation.

REGISTERED OFFICE :

The registered office of the Trust shall be situated at SUNNARI SADAN, Krishna Vihar Colony, Beur, P.O. Anzabad, P.S. Phulwari Shurif, Patna-800002 in the state of Bihar or at such other place or places as may be decided by the Governing Body of the Trust from Time to Time.

3. That the objects for which this trust is established are :-

a- To establish, run, support and grant aid or other financial assistance to schools, colleges, libraries, reading rooms, universities, laboratories, research and other institution of the like nature in India, for use of the students and the staffs and also for the development and advancement of education and diffusion of knowledge amongst the public in general.

b. To establish, maintain and run studentships, scholarships, and render other kind of aid to students including supply of books, stationery, medals and other incentives to study, without any distinction as to caste, colour, race, creed or sex.

c. To promote, establish, support, maintain or grant aid to institutions for the promotion of science, literature, music, drama and fine arts for the preservation of historical monuments and for the research and other institutions, in India, having similar objects for the benefit of the public in general.

d. To establish, maintain or grant aid for the establishment and or maintenance of parks, gardens, gymnasiums, sports clubs, ~~charangshalas~~ and rest houses, for use by public in general.

e. To establish, maintain or grant aid to homes for the aged, orphanages or other establishments for the relief and help to the poor, needy and destitute people, orphans, widows and aged persons.

f. To establish and develop institutions for the physically handicapped and disabled or mentally retarded person and to provide them education, food, clothing or other help.

g. To grant relief and assistance to the needy victims during natural calamities such as famine, earthquake, flood, fire, pestilence, etc. and to give

h. To grant aid or render assistance to other public Charitable trusts or institutions.

4. That the trust may be augmented by the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contribution from time to time.

5. That the Trust fund shall not be applied for any purpose other than those specified in para-3 herein above unless the other objects added to the trust objectives.

6. That for the furtherance of the objects of the trust, the trustees shall have the following powers :-

a. To accept any donation, contribution, grant or subscription in cash or kind, from any person(s), body of persons or trust, with or without conditions.

b. To convert and deal with the trust property and/or any investments for the time being.

c. To invest the Trust fund either in the purpose of Mortgage of immovable property or in deposits with or loans to any company, Bank, firm or any other

such investments, from time to time, at the discretion of the trustees.

d. To sell, dispose of, alienate or otherwise deal with any property comprising the Trust fund.

e. To open account in the name of the trust, trustees and/or Institutions run/conducted by the Trust with a Bank or Banks, to operate such account by one or more of the Trustees or by an agent nominated by the Trustees.

f. To adjust, settle compromise, compound, refer to arbitration, all actions, suits claims, demands and proceedings regarding the Trust Fund.

g. To engage or make provision for the engagement of any person (including all or any of the Trustees and committees or administrator or Managing Trustees or otherwise) for the purpose of the administration of the trust in such manner and subject to such rules and regulations as the Trustees may prescribe and also to nominate or provide for the nomination of the separate Trustees to hold any fund or investment subject to the provisions of this Deed in such manner and subject

h. To make, vary, alter or modify schemes, rules and regulations for carrying out the objects of the trust and for the management of the affairs thereof and/or running any institution in furtherance of the objects of the trust and otherwise for giving effect to the objects of the trust.

i. To set apart and/or allocate the whole or a part of the income or the corpus of the Trust Fund or part thereof for any of the objects of the trust.

j. To apply to the Government, public body, urban local, municipal, district and other bodies, corporation, companies, or persons for and to accept grant of money and of aid, donations, gifts, subscription, and other assistance with a view to promoting the objects of the Trust and to discuss and negotiate with the Government Department, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matter within the objects of the Trust and to conform to any proper condition upon which such grant and other payments may be made.

k- To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable trust, society, association or institutions with similar objects.

l- To establish, promote, manage, organise or maintain or to assist in establishing, promoting managing organising, or maintaining any branch of the trust or any other trust or its branch with objects similar to those of this trust and to promote or carry on the affiliation or amalgamation of such other trust with this trust.

m- To transfer all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagements of this Trust to any one or more of the Trust, societies institutions, or association with which this Trust is authorised to amalgamate.

n- To transfer and hand over the Trust to any other Society, corporation, institution, Trust or organisation on such terms and conditions at the Trustees shall in their absolute discretion think fit and proper to be held by the society, corporation, institution, Trust or Organisation with the powers,
